



NRM Spatial Hub Terms of Use

The NRM Spatial Hub (The Hub) provides land owners, land managers, NRM agencies, emergency services and relevant government authorities with access to datasets and services through the Online Property Planning and Information System (OPPIS), as well as through the website (www.nrmhub.com.au). The rangelands alliance, and their lead agent the Cooperative Research Centre for Spatial Information (CRCSI), administers and operates The Hub, including OPPIS.

The purpose of these terms of use are to govern your use of the NRM Spatial Hub (The Hub). They describe the ways in which you can use the datasets and tools made available through The Hub. We may make changes to these terms of use by publishing them on our website. These terms of use should be read together with The Hub's Privacy Policy.

Please read these terms of use carefully before using The Hub. If you do not accept these terms of use, you may not use The Hub.

Terminology

“The User” in this agreement means any person or pastoral company responsible for the management and/or operation of grazing land, who has been given secure access to The Hub by the Rangelands NRM Alliance or one of its contractors. Users are expected to keep their login details confidential and secure. The User may only access The Hub using their own personal login credentials. The User must not share their account with anyone else. Users should inform The Hub team if they suspect that the security of their account has been compromised, or if their account has been used by an unauthorised person or in an unauthorised way.

“Content” means contributions or content; includes, but is not limited to, spatial data including vector and raster (image) datasets; multimedia such as videos, sound files, photos, other images, music; textual material such as reviews, annotations, comments, forum and blog postings, information; records, metadata; databases, datasets. Content may also include or be referred to as Data.

License

We grant you a licence to access The Hub and to use data and tools, such as OPPIS, subject to these terms of use. You may use, reproduce, publish, communicate or adapt data that you access in the course of your use of The Hub. You may use tools to interrogate and model data, and create and export outputs of data including maps, images and exporting spatial data.

We try to make as much of data available to users as possible. However, some data are restricted to certain categories of users or geographic areas. These restrictions are either technical in nature or made at the discretion of The Hub team. Access to particular datasets may be subject to additional licence terms.



Data 'as is'

We do not warrant that data is accurate, complete or up-to-date, or that its use will not infringe any third party rights. Data comes from a number of third party data providers and those data providers are responsible for their particular datasets. Your use of data is at your own risk. You should check the accuracy, completeness and currency of any dataset with the relevant data provider before relying on it.
